In particular, the Society has selected Junglescapes for this award in recognition of the holistic and inclusive approach you have taken to facilitating the recovery of degraded forest ecosystems and vital habitat across a large area, and working closely and collaboratively with local communities in your efforts to do so. By seeking to develop integrated solutions that draw from local knowledge, address socio-economic concerns in the surrounding communities, and treat the root causes of degradation by fomenting a shift in local perceptions of nature, Junglescapes has great potential to not only achieve lasting improvements for the region's forests and biodiversity, but to improve human well-being across the region as well.
